

AUCKLAND BOWLS EVENT FORMATS



The following formats have been confirmed by the Operations Committee. Full Conditions of Play for each event will be published on the website in due course.

The Operations Committee reserves the right to alter, add to or delete and Conditions of Play to enable the completion of the tournament. If any changes are made you will be notified.

2-4-2 Mixed Pairs:

- 16 ends or 2½hrs
- Sections of 4 – round robin of 3 games
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Auckland Women's Premier Singles:

- 21 shots or 2¼hrs
- Sections of 4 – round robin of 3 games
- 4 Bowls at each end
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Full Day Saturday Interclub: Classic: (Sides of 8)

- Played over 3 weeks 2 games per day. Each Side will play 1 x 4's and 2 x Pairs each round alternating for the afternoon game.
- A draw will necessitate all Sections be 8 Sides. A Side will play 6 games of fours and 12 games of Pairs over the scheduled 3 days.
- A round robin will be played with games played to 18 ends
- Promotion Relegation will apply.

Half Day Saturday Interclub: (Sides of 6) (Dependent on entries)

- 5 weeks - 2 games per afternoon. 2 x Triples.
- A round robin will be played with games lasting 1 hour 20 minutes or 15 ends
- 2 bowls at each end

National Interclub: Division 1 & Division 2 (Sides of 7)

A Singles Player, Pairs Team and a Fours Team

- Singles-4 bowls; Pairs-3 bowls; Fours-2 bowls
- 2 days of Round Robin - Sections of Six (Dependent on entries)
- 3rd Day - Section Winners to play Post Section (Knockout)
- Singles – 21 shots or 2½hrs; Pairs - 18 ends or 2½hrs;
Fours – 15 ends or 2½hrs

Week Day Interclub:

- Scheduled with minimum of 24 teams.
- Team of 6 - 2x Triples Penants Point system
- 5 weeks (zone) round robin - 18 ends - 2½hrs Time Limit
- Qtr, Semi, Finals will be full day on Friday. (numbers dictate if Qtr F played)
- Odd number in Sections – next best may be applicable.

The Trusts New Zealand Open:

Singles

- 4 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 - a round robin of 3 games
- 21 shots or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Pairs (Including Disabled Pairs)

- 3 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 - a round robin of 3 games
- 15 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Triples (Including Disabled Triples)

- 2 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 - A round robin of 3 games
- 15 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

The Controlling Body for this event will be Auckland Bowls who will have the right to alter, add to or delete any Conditions of Play or Special Conditions of Play to enable the completion of the tournament.

Men's and Women's Singles:

- 4 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games
- 21 shots or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Mens and Women's Pairs:

- 3 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 - a round robin of 3 games
- 18 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Men's and Women's Triples:

- 2 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – A round robin of 3 games
- 18 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Mens and Women's Fours:

- 2 Bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games
- 15 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

1-5 Year Interclub (Sides of 6)

- Singles – 4 bowls each end; Pairs – 3 bowls each end; Triples – 2 bowls each end
- 4 sections with a round robin of 3 games
- Singles 21 Shots or 2½hrs; Pairs 15 ends or 2½hrs; Triples 15 ends or 2½hrs

1-5 Year Singles:

- 4 bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games
- 21 shots or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

1-5 Year Pairs:

- 3 bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games (Dependent on entries)
- 18 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

1-5 Year Triples:

- 2 bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games (Dependent on entries)
- 15 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

1-5 Year Fours:

- 2 bowls at each end
- Sections of 4 – a round robin of 3 games (Dependent on entries)
- 18 ends or 2½hrs
- Section Winners through to Post Section which is sudden death

Champion of Champion 1-5 Year Singles:

- 4 bowls at each end
- Sudden Death – 21 shots or 2½hrs

Champion of Champion Singles:

- 4 bowls at each end
- Sudden Death – 21 shots or 2½hrs

Champion of Champion Pairs:

- 3 bowls at each end
- Sudden Death - 18 ends or 2½hrs

Champion of Champion Triples:

- 2 bowls at each end
- Sudden Death - 18 ends or 2½hrs

Champion of Champion Fours:

- 2 bowls at each end
- Sudden Death - 15 ends or 2½hrs
