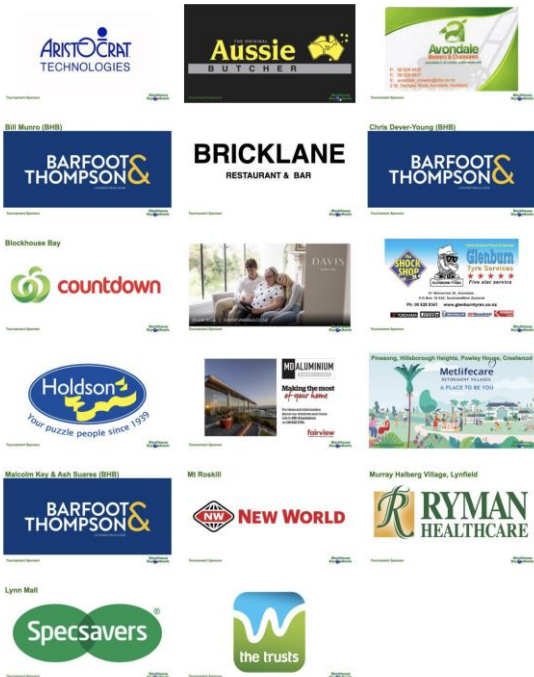

It was a Any Combination Triples, playing over 7 rounds - 4 games on Day 1 and another 3 games on Day 2, each playing 3 bowls. There were 30 teams competing, 16 on one green and 14 on the other; they switched greens on the next day. There were some fierce competitions from the start, with some games won by a mere one shot.
