


Entry lists for these events will be on the board in the club rooms at the beginning of August. Remember you must have paid your subscription for the new season to compete in these events.


#### LAWS & COACHING TIPS

- Where do you place the jack at the 2 metres when it is marked with a "T"? Answer: See photos on left.
- Top View



What happens if that mark is partially or completely covered by a bowl? Answer: See photos on left.





- What causes consistently wobbling bowls? Answer:
  - Middle finger not on the running surface of the bowl;
  - \* Straining to place the thumb on top of the bowl;
  - \* "little finger" problem;
  - \* Running fingers under and across bowl at point of release;
  - Turning the wrist at point of release.
