Measures the Board is or have implemented to help turn things around include:

**PRIL 2025** 

- Moving our accounting and payroll system to Xero in our new financial year (1 May.) A savings of \$569.16 in the first year. More importantly, it will streamline the back office and give more transparency to our accounts. Michael Anderson from Bowls Auckland is kindly helping us with our migration to the new software.
- Update our venue hire and processes. Judy Greatbatch has been working hard on this while Stephen gets his feet under the table.

- Upgrading our processes for advertising and sponsorship as well as seeking new sponsorship opportunities which I have taken on in the interim.
- Liaising with our patron, Catherine Farmer who has helped us with the opportunity to make a presentation to the Whau Community Board.
- Setting up accounts and ordering online where possible. Most of the time, a minimum order to obtain free delivery
- Actioning pre approval of purchases This means Steve has to pre approve any purchases ( however small) unless it is a donation to the club.

- Applying for grants to cover one off costs where possible
- BAC is actively looking at promoting our Club as the Hub by reaching out to our community and offering new events and activities.
